BY THE AUTHORITY:

In an Order dated June 12, 2014, the North Carolina Rural Electrification Authority ("Authority") pursuant to the Federal Communications Connect America Fund Order, FCC-11-161A1, dated November 11, 2012 requested the Telephone Membership Corporations (TMCs) submit to the Authority appropriate intrastate access tariffs supported by verified/notarized statements of compliance in connection with the Connect America Fund Order. The Authority further requested that the supporting statement should provide that documents supporting compliance would be made available to the Authority upon request.


